

# RESIDENTIAL COMPOST BIN MAINTENANCE



- ALWAYS TRY TO KEEP YOUR BIN IN A COOL DRY LOCATION.
- KEEP YOUR BIN LID TIGHTLY SHUT.
- ON THE DAY YOUR BIN IS PICKED UP HOSE THE INSIDE OF YOUR BIN, THE BIN WILL BE EMPTY AND A QUICK RINSE OF WATER IS A GOOD HABIT TO GET INTO. SPRAY WITH AN ALL NATURAL BIODEGRADABLE SOAP TO CLEAN UP ANY EXTRA FOOD RESIDUE AND MAKE IT EXTRA FRESH!
- ON WARM DAYS YOU CAN TAKE YOUR COMPOST IN IT'S BAG AND FREEZE IT. THIS STOPS THE SMELL. OLD SALAD CONTAINERS WORK WELL TO HOLD COMPOST.
- TO DETER BUGS, MAGGOTS ETC. YOU MIGHT TRY LAYERING IN BETWEEN YOUR COMPOST NEWSPAPER. THIS CREATES A BARRIER SO IT IS HARD FOR THE BUGS TO LAY EGGS.
- ANOTHER FLY DETERRENT AND SMELL STOPPER IS TO SPRITZ YOUR BIN CONTENTS WITH WHITE VINEGAR.
- CUSTOMERS WHO HAVE CATS HAVE SPRINKLED A BIT OF THE KITTY LITTER INTO THE BIN AS LIGHT LAYERS WHICH HELPS WITH THE SMELL TOO! (NOT SURE ABOUT THE KITTY LITTER, SOME HAVE NOT SO GOOD CHEMICALS. )
